

# Free School Programs in Manitoba Provincial Parks

Take your class on an adventure and let an interpreter be your guide to a park near you. Guided hikes, visitor centre tours, demonstrations & experiments provide hands-on knowledge that enhances learning. School programs are free of charge and curriculum based. Programs can be one-hour, a half-day or a full day depending on your needs. Plan your students' next adventure today!

Three parks offer year-round school programs and can be booked directly with the park interpreter:
